McCracken's Connection with Healesville RSL
 Robert McCracken (c.1813-1885), arrived at Melbourne in 1841 with his brother Peter. With James Robertson as partner the brothers started the brewing firm of McCracken & Robertson in 1851.
 The partners began with only four barrels of beer at a time. By 1884 their average annual output was around 100,000 barrels, and profits were very good. It retained independence until 1907 when it became a part of Carlton and United Breweries. The Healesville RSL connection comes by way of our Treasurer and former owner of the "Grand Hotel" in Healesville, Peter McCracken a descendant of Robert McCracken. Our Peter McCracken says, "with such a long history, it makes me very proud to bear the McCracken name and even prouder to see it on Tap at the RSL. I simply cant go past the Amber Ale".
